Dave Givens "The Foundations of Democracy at Historic Jamestowne"

Join Jamestown Rediscovery's Director of Archaeology Dave Givens for this special presentation that explores the Rediscovery team's latest findings on the excavations in the 1617 church where Virginia's first General Assembly met in July 1619. Learn how forensic archaeology uncovered detailed evidence of the architecture of this church and others that followed in the mid-17th century. Enjoy a light supper and cocktails in the courtyard as we delve deep into the earliest site of the oldest continuous legislative body in the western hemisphere. Hop on the bus the next day for a private tour of Jamestown with Dave and his colleagues.

Bus Trip Historic Jamestowne

Enjoy a private tour of James Fort, the site of the 1617 church, and the stunning archaeological excavations carried out here since 1994. In the award-winning Archaearium, explore more than 4,000 objects that tell the story of Jamestown from 1607-1624: Powhatan Indian artifacts, a 400-year old writing slate, arms and armor, tools, coins, trade goods, personal items, religious objects and more, including the skeletons and facial reconstructions of some of these early settlers. "Reign and Rebellion" Exhibitions

Explore two new exhibitions at Jamestown Settlement and the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown that tell the story of early Virginia through the Stuart monarchy. Rare artifacts like the Rolfe Family Bible, a mourning ring of Charles I, and shells used by enslaved Africans combine with personal stories to reveal how the Stuart legacy shaped the colony from its founding to the Revolution and a new American identity.
