ABOUT THE PRESENTERS

Calder Loth is the retired Senior Architectural Historian for the Virginia Department of Historic Resources (VDHR), where he was employed for forty years and still works part-time. Loth is a member of the Advisory Council for the Institute of Classical Architecture and Art in New York, where he lectures on classical and traditional architecture. Loth also serves on advisory committees for the University of Virginia, Kenmore, Gunston Hall, Stratford Hall, and Preservation Virginia. He represents VDHR on the Virginia Art and Architectural Review Board. His publications include Lost Virginia: Vanished Architecture of the Old Dominion, Virginia Landmarks of Black History, and the Virginia Landmarks Register.

Katie Brauckmann is a Staff Archaeologist at the Fairfield Foundation and DATA Investigations LLC in Gloucester, Va. Ms. Brauckmann had an interest in archaeology and history from a young age and began working with the Fairfield Foundation as a senior in high school. Since graduation from James Madison University in 2019, she has continued working with Fairfield and has led the field excavations at Historic Christ Church for the last year and a half. These excavations have uncovered features and artifacts relating to the current ca. 1735 church, the ca. 1670 church, and a Native American encampment which predates both structures.
